They are battlefields of the class struggle, battlefields on which the ruling economic class, obtaining its majority by means fair and foul, legislates repeated defeats for the opposition. In this respect we have every reason for pride. Our duty is constantly to advance the cause socialism and communism in accordance with the laws of development of human society, so as to make socialist and communist society a reality as soon as possible. The strictest centralization and discipline are required within the political party of the proletariat in order to counteract this, in order that the organizational role of the proletariat and that is its principle role may be exercised correctly, successfully, victoriously. Gaps and uncertainties are left untouched. The society has been described by some commentators as "communist-bloc" [32] or "anarcho-communist". Simple cooperation within each functional social unit together with single purpose coordination between them provides communism as an advanced industrial society with all the "administration" it requires. Such is the place in history a proletarian leader of the communist cause occupies, compared with that of a leader in the cause of the landlord and the rising mercantile classes. In such a society the production of both material and moral values will develop and flourish mightily and will meet the varied needs of all its members. Further-more, all really major decisions, those bearing on the structure of communism itself, have already been taken by this time. This struggle is one of conflicting ideologies, and it reflects the class struggle in society. The reason is that the historical laws of social development make the progress of human society towards communism inevitable; that latent in the proletariat and the other exploited and oppressed masses of the world lie extremely powerful revolutionary energies which, once mobilized, united and organized, can triumph over all the reactionary forces of the exploiting classes and imperialism; and that the Communist Party and the proletariat are the new and rising forces and whatever is new and rising is invincible. Life in communism is at the opposite extreme from what exists in capitalism. After all, many of the worst administrative complexities are byproducts of present social organization and its accompanying attitudes. But, more than a century and a half later, the jittery gossip about communism continues. In communism, the tie is unknotted, and each person takes part, at one time or another, in many if not most of these activities. To this, a communist, particularly one in a bad mood, might counter you with a picture of a Congolese child mining for the rare elements used inside our smartphones. Wide-scale planning has been enormously successful. We Communist Party members must have the highest goals in our struggle and the highest ideals, while at the same time we must have a practical spirit and do real practical work. Both as a producer and as a consumer, the individual is profoundly affected by the disappearance of the state. With the increasing equalization of incomes, the progressive income tax soon becomes outmoded. After defending the principle of "equal pay for equal work time" as marking a notable advance on ideas governing distribution in capitalism, Marx buds it a "bourgeois limitation.
